U.S. Coast Guard Auxiliary **Historical Interpreter Duty** offered by the *Boston Light Augmentation Program* to assist with Boston Harbor Islands National Park Ranger visitors to Little Brewster Island Boston Light is from Friday, 15 June to Sunday, 30 September 2012 from 0930 to 1630 departing from the Long Warf in downtown Boston.

**Properly worn ODU** (no exceptions): (sew-on: member devices, name, and AUX strip)

**Required training dates:**

Saturday, 19 May 2012 (0900-1300) “ashore” training at Coast Guard Base Boston

**AND**

Saturday, 16 June 2012 (0930-1630) “on-island” orientation at Boston Light  
transportation via the National Park chartered vessel from Long Wharf

**Expectations:** perform a minimum of 3 Interpreter “day duty” per season, properly wearing of the ODU. In 2012, there are 16 weeks of tours held Fri, Sat, and Sun with approximately 48 tour days to choose from.
